- Job vacancies



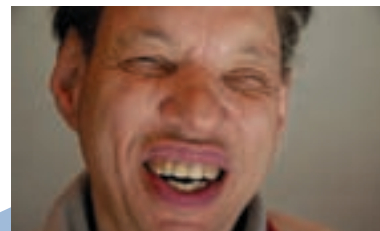
Communication
